A Lunatic Asylum

THE appointment of Julius Streicher, editor of the ra-bid anti-Jewish weekly Der Stuermer, as government com-missioner for Franconia, lends official sanction to the most disgusting and dastardly ac-tivities of this perverted anti-Semite. The articles and cartoons appearing in his Stuermer, often sadistic and pornographic in character, have incited the German populace in the Nurenberg region to anti-Jewish riots and have led to bloodshed. The maddest of all the mad Jew-baiters, Julius Streicher, now becomes a representative of his district in the so-called Bavarian Cabinet Council, Streicher's notorious record as an enemy of the Jew-ish people is based on his long unscrupulous agitation by means of the forged "Protocols" and other exploded myths and legends. He has constant-ly incited acts of violence

against the Jews. against the Jews.
Those who are endeavoring to create a more sympathetic attitude toward Hitler in this country on the ground that Hitler personally is no longer as rabid an anti-Semite as before will have to do a great deal of explaining of this latest appointment of Streicher.

League of Nations Council would have no right to impose special obligations for the protection of racial minorities, jurists of the League are said to have declared.

Under the provisions of the treaty the inhabitants of the Saar valley will have to vote on a re-turn to Germany, inclusion in the French Republic or a continuation of the present League Commission government.

It is understood that the con-clusion of the League jurists is contained in a jurist's memoran-dum which the League committee in charge of organizing the Saar plebiscite will consider when it meets in Rome on Monday.

The opinion of the jurists is based on the fact that the Ver-sailles Treaty clauses dealing with the Saar region do not contain specific regulations for the protection of minorities to enable the League to dictate on the treatment of minorities there.

However, even the formal con-clusions of the jurists cannot pre-vent the Council of the League from specially recommending spe-cial clauses for the protection of minorities in the Saar region.
